APPLICATION TO EMPLOY PSZJ AS TRUSTEE'S COUNSEL

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I.

JURISDICTION

The Court has jurisdiction over the Application pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§157 and 1334. This matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. §157(b)(2). Venue of this proceeding and this Application is properly in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§1408 and 1409.

The statutory bases for the relief sought herein are section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Rule 2014(a) of the Bankruptcy Rules and Local Bankruptcy Rule 2014-1.

II.

BACKGROUND

The Debtor commenced this case by the filing of a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on March 10, 2014. In light of the pending criminal investigation and other ongoing litigation, on March 18, 2014, the United States Trustee filed a *Stipulation Appointing Chapter 11 Trustee* [Docket No. 15] ("Stipulation"), which was signed by both the Debtor and its attorney. The Stipulation was approved by the Bankruptcy Court on March 18, 2014 [Docket No. 16] and an Order was entered by the Court on March 21, 2014 approving the *U.S. Trustee's Application for the Appointment of a Chapter 11 Trustee*, appointing R. Todd Neilson as trustee ("Chapter 11 Trustee") of the Debtor's estate [Docket No. 22].

On April 3, 2014, the Chapter 11 Trustee filed his application to employ PSZJ as his counsel in the Debtor's Chapter 11 case [Docket No. 37].

On April 30, 2014, the Trustee filed a motion to convert this Case to chapter 7 [Docket No. 74].

On May 22, 2014, a hearing was held and the Court granted the Trustee's motion to convert this Case to a chapter 7 and approved the Trustee's application to employ PSZJ as his counsel in the Debtor's Chapter 11 case.

On May 29, 2014, the Court entered an order approving the employment of PSZJ as counsel to the Chapter 11 Trustee [Docket No. 106]. Also on May 29, 2014, the Court entered an order converting this Case to chapter 7 [Docket No. 108]. A *Notice of Appointment of Trustee and Fixing*

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of Bond; Acceptance of Appointment as Interim Trustee was filed on June 10, 2014 [Docket No. 126], appointing R. Todd Neilson as Trustee.

III.

RELIEF REQUESTED

By this Application, the Trustee seeks to employ and retain PSZJ as his general bankruptcy counsel effective *nunc pro tunc* to May 22, 2014, the date upon which a hearing was held and the Court granted the Trustee's motion to convert this Case to case under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code.

A. Services to be Provided

The professional services that PSZJ will render to the Trustee may include, without limitation, the following:

- a. Advising the Trustee concerning the rights and remedies of the Estate in regard to the assets of the Estate, and with respect to secured, administrative, priority and general unsecured claims, including, but not limited to, the review and reconciliation of Claims;
- b. Representing the Trustee in connection with financial and business matters, including the sale of any assets and potential recovery of assets;
- c. Representing the Trustee in connection with the investigation and prosecution, to the extent the Trustee deems appropriate, potential causes of action against persons or entities relating to the Estate, including, but not limited to, potential claims against insiders and related parties;
- d. Investigating and prosecuting preference, fraudulent transfer and other actions, if any, arising under the Trustee's avoiding powers;
- e. Representing the Trustee in any proceeding or hearing in the Bankruptcy

 Court, and in any action in other courts where the rights of the Estate may be litigated or affected;
- f. Conducting examinations of witnesses, claimants, or adverse parties and preparing and assisting in the preparation of motions, applications, answers, orders, memoranda, reports and accounts;

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- g. Advising the Trustee concerning the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules and the requirements of the Office of the United States

 Trustee relating to the administration of the estate and assisting, if requested by the Trustee, in the filing of Schedules, Statement of Financial Affairs and other required documents; and
- h. Rendering such other advice and service, as the Trustee may require in connection with this Case.

B. PSZJ's Qualifications

PSZ&J is a firm of approximately 63 attorneys with a practice concentrated on restructurings, bankruptcy reorganizations and liquidations, litigation and commercial issues. PSZ&J attorneys have extensive experience representing a wide range of debtors in various industries, chapter 11 trustees, chapter 7 trustees, creditors' committees, creditors, asset purchasers, investors and other parties in interest in a wide variety of bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings. More information about PSZ&J generally and its expertise as counsel to trustees specifically is available on its website at www.pszjlaw.com.

The Trustee believes that PSZ&J is well qualified to render the foregoing services. A copy of the biography of Linda F. Cantor, and Jason S. Pomerantz the PSZ&J attorneys currently expected to be principally responsible for rendering services to the Trustee in this Case, are attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Linda F. Cantor in support hereof (the "Cantor Declaration"), which is being filed concurrently herewith.

To the best of the Trustee's knowledge and based upon the Cantor Declaration attached hereto, neither PSZJ nor any of its partners, of counsel, or associates has any connection with the Trustee, the Debtor, any creditors of the estate, any party in interest, their respective attorneys or accountants, the United States Trustee, or any person employed in the Office of the United States Trustee, except to the extent set forth in the Cantor Declaration.

In particular, the Cantor Declaration discloses the following:

a. PSZJ has in the past and/or is presently representing R. Todd Neilson in his capacity as a court appointed chapter 11 trustee, a court appointed chapter 7 trustee, examiner, trustee of liquidating trusts, and as plan disbursing agent. PSZJ was employed by the Trustee to

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represent him in this Case prior to its conversion to chapter 7, as counsel to the Chapter 11 Trustee.
PSZJ has also represented chapter 11 debtors in whose cases Mr. Neilson served as chief
restructuring officer, residual trustee and as a member of the debtor's board of directors as an
independent director. PSZJ has also represented debtors, creditors' committees and parties in
bankruptcy proceedings in which Mr. Neilson's current firm, Berkeley Research Group, LLC, and/or
principals of such firm or Mr. Neilson's prior firms acted as expert witnesses, consultants, financial
advisors, accountants, forensic accountants and valuation experts. Other than PSZJ's representation
of the Trustee in the chapter 11 case of this Debtor, all such other representations are and were in
other cases wholly unrelated to this Case.

- PSZJ represents many committees whose members may be creditors in the b. Debtor's chapter 11 case; however, PSZJ is not representing any of those entities in this Case and will not represent any members of those committees in any claims that they may have collectively or individually against the Debtor.
- PSZJ and certain of its partners, counsel and associates may have in the past c. represented, and may currently represent and likely in the future will represent creditors of the Debtor in connection with matters unrelated to the Debtor and this case. At this time, PSZJ is not aware of any current representations in unrelated cases of parties who are creditors or other parties on its conflicts check.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Trustee does not believe that any of the relationships described herein will in any way impair PSZJ's independence or ability to objectively perform the required services for the Trustee.

To the best of the Trustee's knowledge and based upon the attached Cantor Declaration, neither PSZJ nor any of its partners, of counsel, or associates is a creditor, equity security holder, or an "insider" of the Debtor as that term is defined in section 101(31) of the Bankruptcy Code.

To the best of the Trustee's knowledge and based upon the Cantor Declaration, neither PSZJ nor any of its partners, of counsel, or associates is or was, within two years before the date of filing of the petition, a director, officer or employee of the Debtor.

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To the best of the Trustee's knowledge and based upon the Cantor Declaration, neither PSZJ nor any of its partners, of counsel, or associates has any interest materially adverse to the interest of the estate or of any class of creditors or equity security holders, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship to, connection with, or interest in, the Debtor or for any other reason. Accordingly, PSZJ and its partners, of counsel, and associates are "disinterested persons" as that term is defined and used in sections 101(14) and 327 of the Bankruptcy Code.

C. Terms of Retention

Subject to the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Bankruptcy Rules and this Court's rules, the Trustee proposes to pay PSZJ its customary hourly rates in effect from time to time and to reimburse PSZJ according to its customary reimbursement policies. All services provided by PSZJ will be provided by PSZJ partners, associates, of counsel, paraprofessionals, and staff working under the direct supervision of Linda F. Cantor. The Trustee understands that various levels of professionals and paraprofessionals will be utilized to ensure that billing rates are in line with the level of responsibility and specialization of tasks. A schedule of the normal hourly rates currently in effect for PSZJ attorneys and paraprofessionals as of January 1, 2014 is attached hereto as Exhibit A. PSZJ adjusts its hourly rates from time to time.

PSZJ has not received or requested a retainer in contemplation of its proposed employment. However, it is contemplated that PSZJ will seek interim compensation during the case as permitted by sections 330 and 3311 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2016 and the Local Bankruptcy Rules. PSZJ understands that its compensation in this case is subject to the prior approval of this Court. No compensation will be paid except upon application to and approval by this Court after notice and a hearing in accordance with sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2016, and Local Bankruptcy Rule 2016-1.

IV.

NOTICE

Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 2014-1(b)(2)(A), notice of this Application was provided and filed concurrently herewith to the Debtor, the Debtor's counsel, the United States Trustee, and parties requesting special notice.

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Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 2014-1(b)(4), a hearing is not required in connection with the Application unless requested by the United States Trustee, a party in interest, or otherwise ordered by the Court. Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 2014-1(b)(3)(E), any response to the Application and request for hearing must be in the form prescribed by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9013-1(f)(1) and must be filed with the Court and served upon the Trustee and the United States Trustee no later than fourteen (14) days from the date of service of notice of the filing of the Application.

WHEREFORE, the Trustee requests that this Court approve the employment of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP, as his general bankruptcy counsel, to render services as described above, with compensation to be paid by the Estate as an administrative expense in such amounts as this Court may hereafter determine and allow.
