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Trustee is in the process of reviewing the Debtor's books and records, as well as customer lists and other operating information, to determine the assets of the estate. For this reason, the Trustee filed a motion for an extension of time until September 10, 2014, to file the Debtor's Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and Statement of Financial Affairs for the Debtor (collectively, the "Schedules and SOFA") [Docket No. 127]. That motion was granted by Order entered July 1, 2014 [Docket No 146].

At the time of the conversion of this Chapter 11 case to one under Chapter 7, there was a total of \$54,707.91 in the Trustee's bank accounts. Based on the limited information available, the remaining assets of the estate which may be transferred to the Chapter 7 Trustee consist of, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. The Debtor's customer lists;
- b. Potential preference and other causes of action;
- Twenty-two pallets consisting of approximately five hundred boxes of
  miscellaneous graded and ungraded coins, as well as gold and silver ingots
  and bullion [currently held by the Department of Justice];
- d. Debtor's domain names;
- e. Debtor's e-mail addresses; and
- f. Debtor's telephone numbers.

As set forth in the monthly operating reports filed in the chapter 11 case, the Trustee expects to receive a cashier's check from California Bank within the next 30-45 days in the amount of \$370,120.25, representing funds that were previously sent by California Bank but not received by the chapter 11 trustee.

## 2. Liabilities Incurred Postpetition

Subsequent to the commencement of the Debtor's Chapter 11 case, the debts listed on **Exhibit "A"**, attached hereto, were incurred and remain unpaid as of the date of the conversion of the case to one under Chapter 7. The outstanding post-petition liabilities total approximately \$97,484.33. This amount includes approximate professional fees and expenses and other costs of administration during the pendency of the Chapter 11 case which have not been paid.

#### DECLARATION OF R. TODD NEILSON

### I, R. TODD NEILSON, declare as follows:

- 1. I am the former Chapter 11 Trustee for The Tulving Company, Inc. ("Debtor") the Chapter 7 Debtor herein. I am aware of the facts contained herein of my personal knowledge and would be competent to testify thereto if called as a witness.
- 2. This case will be very difficult to administer. There are numerous unsophisticated creditors, many of whom have lost their life savings in what appears to be a substantial fraud. It will require all of the experience which I have acquired over the past 37 years to avoid completely draining the estate of funds to provide the creditors with a distribution.
- 3. I have been in contact with the Department of Justice ("DOJ") based in North Carolina which is responsible for the ongoing investigation of the Tulving Company and Mr. Tulving. The DOJ has seized all the tangible assets of the Debtor as well as all computers and servers.
- 4. I have limited information concerning the scope of assets in this case. The Debtor did not file Schedules of Assets and Liabilities or a Statement of Financial Affairs. However, I am in the process of reviewing the Debtor's books and records, as well as customer lists and other operating information.
- 5. I reviewed Exhibit "A", attached hereto, which sets forth the debts incurred by the Debtor after the commencement of the Debtor's Chapter 11 case and remain unpaid as of the date of the conversion of the case to one under Chapter 7 and verify its accuracy.
- 6. I have read the statements contained in the foregoing Chapter 11 Trustee's Final Report and Account and Schedule of Post-Petition Debts, pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 2015-2 and Federal Bankruptcy Rule 1019-5, and verify that the statements contained therein are true according to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.
