as the duly appointed, authorized and acting Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") of The Tulving Company, Inc. Appearances at the hearing were waived by the Court.

The Court has considered the Motion and arguments set forth therein, the Declaration of R. Todd Neilson filed in support thereof, and the record in this Case.

The Court hereby finds that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § § 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), (c) notice of the Motion was sufficient and proper, (d) the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein, and (e) approval of the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor's estate;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
- 2. The Trustee is authorized to take such actions as are reasonable and appropriate to implement the Proposal for the sale of the Seized Items and disbursement of cash and Error Coins to Victim/Creditors as described in the Motion.
- 3. The Trustee shall revise the final list of Victim/Creditors and their respective losses appended to the Motion as Exhibit "A" (the "Final List") and file a revised Final List after the claims of Victim/Creditors have been resolved by Order of the Court or pursuant to agreement of the parties.
- 4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to any matters, rights or disputes arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
