

My name is Nayda Easley and I am a customer of Bullion Direct (account # 442964055.) Upon receiving the "Objection to Order of disposition of Undeposited Checks," I need to inform you that I put a stop payment on the check in question, #9022 for \$826.91, drawn on account # XXXXXXX715, on July 17, 2015. I did not receive your notification of The Bullion Direct, Inc. bankruptcy, Case Number 15-10940-tmd, until 7/23/15. You're document itself was dated 7/21/15.

I stopped payment because it had been 28 days since I had issued the check and I had never been notified that it had been received by Bullion Direct.

Also the check for another order I had placed 5/16/2015, (order # Z7FJIRPMY0) had been cashed on 5/22/2015, yet, by July 17, 2015, I had still not received the coins. Several days after receiving your notice of Bankruptcy dated 7/21/2015, I realized why, and I filed a "Proof of Claim" for order # Z7FJIRPMY0 in the amount of \$855.59.

I am sorry for Bullion Direct's troubles, but I see no reason, under these circumstances, why I should issue another check in the amount of \$826.91, when the first one was not acknowledged for almost a month, nor honored by the merchandise I should have received. Therefore, I object and <u>do not consent</u> to the deposit of check # 9022 and ask for its return. Please provide me with written notice of any further proceedings in relation to my check at the address below.
