I do so on the grounds that I have a claim against a portion of their inventory of silver. I submitted a proof of claim on July 21, 2016, and an amended proof of claim on August 19, 2016. The claim number is 2547. In the claim, I have documents and pictures of my assets, along with weights and signatures of personnel that received them on behalf of Northwest Territorial Mint, LLC. Those assets are not the property of Northwest Territorial Mint. LLC or K&L Gates LLP and, therefore, are not subject to public auction.

Furthermore, I did not receive the amended notice in sufficient time to respond to the court by February 5, 2018 for a hearing on February 9th. According to due process of law, this constitutes unlawful, untimely, and deficient notice by the court to an asset holder. The Motion to Auction inventory free and clear of all liens, claims, interests, and encumbrances, on March 9, 2018, which we have not received formal notice of, must be immediately stopped until further investigation can determine if any of the inventory to be auctioned is property that has been identified by my claim.
